The Great Get Together is an event being promoted in the local schools to support the friends and family of Jo Cox in celebrating and affirming her belief that we have 'more in common' as communities and that we should celebrate this by 'getting together' on the anniversary of her death. We would very much like to support this and so will be holding a 'bring and buy' food stall from 2.30 pm in school. We would like as many students and pupils as possible to bring some baked products (sweet or savoury) to school on Friday 16 June 2017.

These items will be sold to students/pupils and their parents from 2.30 pm with buyers encouraged where possible to sit, have a drink and enjoy their purchases together. Primary pupils will join their parents from 2.30 pm and secondary phase students will join them from 3.00 pm.

We recognise that The Great Get Together does fall within Ramadan, which does limit the involvement of our Muslim families and some of our older students. However, we do hope something can be purchased to be eaten once the fast is broken for that day. All proceeds will be donated to the Jo Cox Foundation which supports three main charities: the Royal Voluntary Service, Hope Not Hate and the White Helmets.
